- 1. WHEREAS, senators of the ASUW Student Government have the
- 2. responsibility to represent their constituents; and
- 3. WHEREAS, all ASUW senate meetings are considered
- 4. mandatory; and
- 5. WHEREAS, unexcused absences of senators may inhibit the
- 6. effectiveness of ASUW senate meetings;
- 7. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the
- 8. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that
- 9. failure of a senator to attend a senate meeting will
- 10. constitute an unexcused absence. Unexcused absences will
- 11. be reported to the Steering Committee by the Vice President
- 12. of ASUW.
- 13. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that an unexcused absence
- 14. may be appealed to the Steering Committee within five business
- 15. days or they shall become permanent and two unexcused
- 16. absences per semester may result in the recommendation from
- 17. the Steering Committee to the ASUW Student Senate that the
- 18. senator be removed from his/her elected office.
