THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the 16. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that a 17. referendum be placed on the ASUW election ballot asking, 18. "Should the OPTION be made available to pay a \$1.00 fee to go towards the UW Recycling Program?" 19.
