



1. WHEREAS, every student has a right to know the purpose, scope,
2. and content of a course; and
3. WHEREAS, students have a right to know what instructors expect
4. in terms of academic performance on homework assignments,
5. exams, term papers, etc.; and
6. WHEREAS, students have a right to know beforehand the grading
7. scale and basis of determination;
8. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
9. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we
10. support the change in UniReg 29, Section II, Item (c) as
11. proposed by the Faculty Senate, which reads:
12.       c. Students have a right to expect a competent
13.       and conscientious effort from their instructors.
14.       At the beginning of each course, the instructor
15.       shall provide the students, in writing, statements of:
  - (i)       Purpose, scope, and content of the course
  - (ii)      Expectations of student performance, and
  - (iii)     How grades are determined
