- 1. WHEREAS, secondhand smoke, also known as ETS (Environmental
- 2. Tobacco Smoke), is responsible for over 3000 lung cancer
- 3. deaths per year; and
- 4. WHEREAS, secondhand smoke has been classified as a Class A
- 5. carcinogen; and
- 6. WHEREAS, the University has a responsibility to maintain a
- 7. safe and comfortable atmosphere; and
- 8. WHEREAS, the current University Regulation 180 regarding
- 9. smoking allows the administrator of each University facility
- 10. to independently designate up to 50% of the facility's public
- 11. space as areas where smoking is permitted; and
- 12. WHEREAS, the smoking policy in all private offices is
- 13. determined by the occupant; and
- 14. WHEREAS, the limitation of smoking to specific areas of a
- 15. building cannot fully protect unwilling individuals from
- 16. exposure to the possible deadly effects of secondhand smoke;
- 17. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
- 18. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we
- 19. recommend that smoking be prohibited throughout all University
- 20. enclosed facilities including the residence halls, but
- 21. excluding other residential facilities owned, leased or
- 22. operated by the University.
