WHEREAS, parking availability has been a long standing concern of the UW campus community; and 2. 3. WHEREAS, the current amount of spaces are inadequate to accommodate the needs of UW faculty, staff, and students; and 4. 5. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Campus Police currently 6. issue on average approximately 1700 to 2200 tickets per month 7. with a substantial percentage being issued for violation under code N6 (Not Parking in Assigned Area) and code T (Timed 8. 9. Parking); and 10. WHEREAS, the bulk of citations are issued during peak course 11. load hours (8-noon); and 12. WHEREAS, many faculty, staff, and students are victims of the 13. current parking shortfall and are incurring substantial debt; THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the 14. 15. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we 16. encourage a revision of the current UWPD fine structure to 17. include a reduction of the existing \$10 fines for code N (Not 18.
