1 WHEREAS, comparable institutions within the United States as well

- 2 as in this region have deemed it necessary to extend protection
- 3 from discrimination beyond the minimum federal requirements (see
- 4 addendum); and
- 5 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming has the power to extend
- 6 protection against discrimination beyond the minimum federal
- 7 requirements; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in accordance with the mission statement of the University
- 9 of Wyoming, "it (University of Wyoming) will be particularly
- 10 attentive to the needs of Wyoming students, members of
- 11 underrepresented groups, and the gifted"; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming statement on Discrimination and
- 13 Harassment dated December 14, 1990 reads:

A campus environment characterized by diversity, free 14 inquiry, free expression and balanced by interpersonal 15 civility has always been, and continues to be, a top 16 priority of the University of Wyoming. Civil discourse 17 18 is an essential aspect of the search for and transmission 19 Words and actions that promote and encourage knowledge, self-worth, respect, and dignity are 20 21 consistent with the University's mission. Conversely, words or actions that reflect prejudice, stereotypes, and 22 discrimination are antithetical to the mission of the 23 24 University and cannot be countenanced. Specifically, racist and other discriminatory or harassing conduct 25 26 based on gender, color, disability, sexual orientation, 27 religious preference, national origin, ancestry, or age impair and disrupt legitimate University functions. 28

Every effort, within the context and protection of First 29 Amendment rights, will be expended to eliminate such 30 conduct from the campus community. Teaching our students 31 to live productively in a multi-cultural/multi-ethnic 32 society is a process that must take place within a 33 constructive and harmonious multi-cultural/multi-ethnic 34 environment here at the University of Wyoming. It is the 35 obligation of the faculty, staff, students, and the 36 administration of the University of Wyoming to provide 37 38 this environment.

- 40 WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 41 support and follow President Roark's Statement on Discrimination
- 42 and Harassment in all of its roles and functions; and
- 43 WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming on
- 44 March 3, 1992, passed Senate Resolution #1706 in support of
- 45 amending Unireg 3 to comply with the Presidential Statement;
- 46 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the
- 47 University of Wyoming that section 2 (re: Policy), 5a (re:
- 48 Recruiting), 6a (re: Employment and Placement), and 8b (re:
- 49 Promotions, Transfers, Demotions and Layoffs) of Unireg 3 be
- 50 amended to read "...without regard to sex, race, political belief,
- 51 disability, sexual orientation, religion, national origin,
- 52 ancestry, age or veteran status."
- 53 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that Unireg 29 section Ia be
- 54 amended to read "...without regard to sex, race, political belief,
- 55 disability, sexual orientation, religion, national origin,
- 56 ancestry, age or veteran status."
