

SENATE RESOLUTION #1804

Title: Summer Student Health Fee
Date: November 7, 1995
Authors: Student Housing and Health
Sponsors: Senators Copenhaver, Fattorini, Haiar, Loveland,
Mack, Weber, and Walters

1 WHEREAS, there are no student health services available to
2 students who are not enrolled in summer classes; and
3 WHEREAS, there is a significant number of students who require
4 medical and clinical attention annually and by law cannot be
5 abandoned; and
6 WHEREAS, students enrolled in summer school presently pay
7 \$2.58 per credit hour for health services; and
8 WHEREAS, the current fees are not sufficient to meet rising
9 medical costs and do not allow for an increase in facility
10 efficiency; and
11 WHEREAS, the Student Health Service is self-sustaining;
12 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
13 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that a \$30.00
14 flat fee shall be optional for those students not enrolling in
15 the summer session who were enrolled in the previous spring
16 semester and who are registered for the upcoming fall
17 semester; and
18 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that students enrolled in
19 summer school pay \$3 per credit hour for health services; and
20 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that students enrolled
21 during the academic year pay \$55 per semester for student

22 health services.
