- 1 WHEREAS, the current Freshman Live-In Proposal is beneficial
- 2 to the students of the University of Wyoming because there is
- a correlation between living on campus and retention; and
- WHEREAS, the 30-mile radius could cause loss of enrollment due
- 5 to the accessibility of junior colleges; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a goal of the University of Wyoming is to maintain a
- 7 high level of freshman enrollment; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the current Freshman Live-In Proposal fails to
- 9 reasonably address exemptions to the Freshman Live-In
- 10 Proposal;
- 11 THEREFORE; be it resolved by the Student Senate of the
- 12 Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that the
- 13 following lines be stricken from the Freshman Live-In
- 14 Proposal:
- * have completed 30 or more credit hours of UW college
- 16 work
- * reside with parent(s) or legal guardian(s) within a 30
- 18 mile radius of Laramie (documentation required)
- * transfer student with 30 or more hours of UW approved
- 20 credit
- 21 THEREFORE; be it further resolved that the following

22	exemptions be added in place of those stricken:
23	* upon completion of two semesters as a full-time student
24	of the University of Wyoming
25	<pre>* reside with parent(s) or legal guardian(s)</pre>
26	(documentation required)
27	* transfer student that has completed two full-time
28	semesters at a prior college or university institution
29	THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the following additions
30	be added to the Freshman Live-In Policy:
31	1) The current Fraternity and Sorority Move-in policy as
32	stated in the current housing agreement be transferred to the
33	Freshman Live-In Policy
34	2) A student committee to address student appeals be
35	implemented to the Freshman Live-In Policy.
