Title: Submission of Fee Increases and Other Student Issues

1 WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming Student Senate
2 needs a reasonable amount of time to talk to its constituents on matters regarding
3 student issues; and

4 WHEREAS, in the past, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
5 Student Senate has often been notified of pending fee increases, tuition increases, and
6 other student issues in a belated manner; and

7 WHEREAS, this untimeliness in notification often results in lack of sufficient time to
8 gather information and receive adequate student input; and

9 WHEREAS, when those who propose fees and changes to student issues notify the
10 students in a timely manner, the students can further inform the Trustees of student
11 opinion in the aforementioned manner.

12 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University of
13 Wyoming Student Senate, as representatives of the student body, that fee increases and
14 changes to student issues be submitted to the ASUW Budget & Planning Committee
15 for a recommendation to the ASUW Student Senate.
