- 1. WHEREAS, Article IV, Section I, paragraph B, of the Constitution of the Associated
- 2. Students of the University of Wyoming is ambiguous in its nature; and
- 3. WHEREAS, it is not the intent of the Constitution to exclude graduate students who were
- 4. undergraduates at this University from holding office; and
- 5. WHEREAS, any distinction between graduate and professional students in Section 1 is
- 6. subjective at best.
- 7. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
- 8. University of Wyoming, that the Student Senate proposes that Article IV, Section 1,
- 9. Paragraph B, of the Constitution of the Associated Students of the University of
- 10. Wyoming be changed to read as follows: "As graduate students or professional students.
- 11. in the case of the ASUW President, ASUW Vice President, and all members of the
- 12. Judicial Council, have completed not less than eighteen hours of University of Wyoming
- 13. credit at the beginning of the academic year of their terms of office unless they have
- 14. completed their undergraduate degree at the University of Wyoming; and".
