- 9. paragraph J, subparagraph 2 of the ASUW Constitution be amended to read as
- 10. follows: "...advice and consent of the ASUW Student Senate and review..."
- 11. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
- 12. of the University of Wyoming, that the Student Senate proposes that Article VI,
- 13. Section 6, paragraph J, subparagraph 3 of the ASUW Constitution be amended to
- 14. read as follows: "...be composed of the student senator from the College of Law and
- 15. a minimum of four students appointed by the ASUW President..."
