- 1. WHEREAS, Article III of the ASUW By-Laws needs to be updated; and
- 2. WHEREAS, several parts are contradictory.
- 3. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of
- 4. the University of Wyoming that Article III, Elections, of the ASUW By-Laws be
- 5. amended to read as follows: Article III, B-5 strike 'In such case. . . general
- 6. election."; Article III, C-6, and C-6 (a) strike "The number...college."; C-6 shall
- 7. read "The number of candidates shall not exceed twice the number of senators
- 8. for that college, unless there is a tie for the last place in that college, in which case
- 9. all candidates will be allowed in the general election"; F-1 (b) to read "He must
- 10. have a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average if an undergraduate, 3.0
- 11. cumulative grade point average if a graduate or professional student, unless such
- 12. a cumulative grade point average is not required by his particular graduate or
- 13. professional program; F-2 (a) shall read as follows: "Only a full-time
- 14. undergraduate or law student with a 2.0 cumulative grade point average, or a full
- 15. time graduate student with a 3.0 cumulative grade point average shall be eligible.
- 16. Undergraduate students must have attained junior class standing or higher the
- 17. semester following the election to be eligible."
