## SENATE BILL #1904

Title: ASUW Senate Meeting Location Constitutional Changes

1. WHEREAS, the preamble to the Constitution of the Associated Students of the

2. University of Wyoming states that students have the right, as well as the

3. obligation, to play a significant role in guiding their university; and

4. WHEREAS, there is currently a lack of community and campus participation at

5. Student Senate meetings of the Associated Students of the University of

6. Wyoming; and

7. WHEREAS, a committed outreach effort through alternative meeting locations of

8. the ASUW Senate may increase awareness and participation; and

9. WHEREAS, neither the Constitution nor the Rules and Procedures of the

10. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming mandate the location of

11. regular meetings.

12. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of

13. the University of Wyoming that Article VI, Section 5, paragraphs B through D

14. of the Constitution of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming be

15. re-lettered C through E; and

16. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated

17. Students of the University of Wyoming that Article VI, Section 5, the new

18. paragraph B will read as follows: "Regular ASUW Senate meetings shall be

relocated as determined by the ASUW Senate a minimum of once per 19. semester." 20. 21. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated 22. Students of the University of Wyoming that line 1 of the Rules and Procedures 23. of the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming 24. shall then read: "Time of meeting - regular meetings shall be determined 25. according to Article 6, Section 5-A and B of the ASUW Constitution." **Referred to:** Constitution Signed: Date of Passage: February 2, 1999 "Being enacted on February 3, 1999, I do hereby sign my name hereto and ASUW President approve this Senate action."
