- 1. WHEREAS, the University President is the only authority over the ASUW
- 2. Judicial Council (ASUW Constitution, Article 8, Section 3-A); and
- 3 WHEREAS, ASUW Judicial Council decisions are often of a timely nature; and
- 4. WHEREAS, the ASUW Judicial Council "must meet upon the complaint within
- 5. ten (10) school days" (ASUW Constitution, Article 8, Section 5); and
- 6. WHEREAS, the University President currently has no time frame on which to
- 7. respond to Judicial Council's decisions.
- 8. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
- 9. Wyoming that Article 8, Section 3-A of the ASUW Constitution be changed to
- 10. read as follows: "Subject to the approval of the University President, the ASUW
- 11. Judicial Council shall be the final authority in interpretations of the ASUW
- 12. Constitution and/or the ASUW By-Laws. If the University President has not
- 13. issued a written disapproval within 10 school days, the ASUW Judicial Council
- 14. decision will stand. If the President is unavailable he may appoint a designee to
- 15. act on his behalf."
