- 1. WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
- 2. fee has not been increased since 1997; and
- 3. WHEREAS, the costs associated with funding ASUW programs and services
- 4. have significantly increased with every fiscal year; and
- 5. WHEREAS, an increasing number of funded recognized student organizations
- 6. has increased the financial demands for available student fees; and
- 7. WHEREAS, there exists a need for increased diversity in programming; and
- 8. WHEREAS, it is the desire of ASUW to follow University precedent in
- 9. providing an annual salary increase to benefited employees; and
- 10. WHEREAS, the need to meet continuing advancements in technology creates
- 11. a need for additional funds; and
- 12. WHEREAS, the reserve should remain intact for unanticipated special
- 13. projects.
- 14. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
- 15. Wyoming that the ASUW fee be raised from \$25.00 per semester to \$28.00
- 16. per semester beginning Fiscal Year 2002; and
- 17. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Associated Students of the

- 18. University of Wyoming that the ASUW Budget and Planning Committee be
- 19. required to review and report to the ASUW Senate annually on the
- 20. adequacy of the ASUW student fee.
