

SENATE BILL #1977

Title: Deadline of Credit Hour Requirement

Date: March 2, 2001

1. WHEREAS, ambiguity in the ASUW Constitution has caused problems
2. concerning the eligibility of vice presidential and presidential candidates; and
3. WHEREAS, the exact date of the completion of the hour requirement for
4. these candidates is not explicitly stated; and
5. WHEREAS, the winning vice presidential and presidential candidates are
6. required to complete a paid ten week internship during the summer; and
7. WHEREAS, the experience gained and the contacts made during this
8. internship are essential to the governance during the entire term.
9. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated
10. Students of the University of Wyoming that Article V, Section 1, Sub-
11. sections A and B be amended to read as follows: A. As undergraduate
12. students, in the case of the ASUW President, ASUW Vice President, and all
13. members of the Judicial Council, have completed not less than sixty (60)
14. hours of University credit prior to June 10 of the calendar year in which they
15. are elected; or B. As graduate students or professional students, in the case of
16. the ASUW President, ASUW Vice President, and all members of the Judicial
17. Council, have completed not less than eighteen (18) hours of University of
18. Wyoming credit by June 10 of the calendar year in which they were elected

19. unless they completed an undergraduate degree at the University of

20. Wyoming.
