

**SENATE BILL #1998**

**Title: Restructuring of the ASUW Constitution**

**Date: February 22, 2002**

**Sponsors: Senators Dollison and Pederson**

1. WHEREAS, the current ASUW Constitution is a twenty-one (21) page
2. document; and
3. WHEREAS, the Constitution should provide the most basic framework for
4. the ASUW Senate; and
5. WHEREAS, the Constitution should explain the fundamental principles of the
6. ASUW Senate; and
7. WHEREAS, the current ASUW Constitution contains several pages of details
8. concerning the specific procedures for the ASUW Senate's functioning; and
9. WHEREAS, the ASUW Constitution should be rarely revised; and
10. WHEREAS, the ASUW Constitution has been revised annually for the last
11. nine years; and
12. WHEREAS, this proposed revision of the ASUW Constitution focuses on
13. clarity, consistency, and conciseness.
14. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
15. Wyoming that the proposed changes in the attached document be made to the
16. ASUW Constitution; and
17. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Associated Students of the
18. University of Wyoming that the proposed changes to the Constitution be

19. forwarded for approval by the Student Body.
