**Title:** ASUW By-Law Changes

1. WHEREAS, the By-Laws should outline the specific procedures for ASUW's
2. functioning; and
3. WHEREAS, the By-Laws should provide further definition to the ASUW
4. Constitution; and
5. WHEREAS, the current By-Laws of ASUW are insufficient in outlining the
6. specific procedures for ASUW's functioning and lack detail in further
7. defining ASUW's Constitution; and
8. WHEREAS, the current By-Laws lack a Code of Ethics; and
9. WHEREAS, Senate Bill #1998 places much of the material from the ASUW
10. Constitution into the By-Laws; and
11. WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws should agree.
12. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of
13. Wyoming that the proposed changes in the attached document be made to the
14. ASUW By-Laws upon the approval of ASUW Constitutional changes,
15. stipulated in Senate Bill #1998, as per a vote of the student body in the ASUW
16. General Election on April 10, 2002.
