

SENATE RESOLUTION #2001

Title: Transfer of Computer Classes
Date: March 7, 2002
Authors: Committee of Academics and Technology
Sponsors: Senators Cook, Kirkbride, and Bill Murphy

1. WHEREAS, application computer classes, such as PageMaker, PowerPoint,
2. etc., taken for credit at another accredited academic institution do not
3. currently transfer; and
4. WHEREAS, some other said institutions require students to take computer
5. application classes; and
6. WHEREAS, non-transfer of credits could result in lower class standing (i.e.
7. junior to sophomore), which could hinder students from the ability to register
8. earlier or apply for scholarships, financial aid, honoraries, etc.; and
9. WHEREAS, non-transfer of credits could discourage students from
10. transferring to the University of Wyoming.
11. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University of
12. Wyoming that such courses be classified as hours not counted towards
13. degrees, similar to the current policy for lower division military hours.
