- 1. WHEREAS, application computer classes, such as PageMaker, PowerPoint,
- 2. etc., taken for credit at another accredited academic institution do not
- 3. currently transfer; and
- 4. WHEREAS, some other said institutions require students to take computer
- 5. application classes; and
- 6. WHEREAS, non-transfer of credits could result in lower class standing (i.e.
- 7. junior to sophomore), which could hinder students from the ability to register
- 8. earlier or apply for scholarships, financial aid, honoraries, etc.; and
- 9. WHEREAS, non-transfer of credits could discourage students from
- 10. transferring to the University of Wyoming.
- 11. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University of
- 12. Wyoming that such courses be classified as hours not counted towards
- 13. degrees, similar to the current policy for lower division military hours.
