

SENATE BILL #2014

Title: UW Gold Nomination Requirements

Date: October 17, 2002

Authors: Vice President Reed, Senator Fisher

Sponsors: Senators Fisher, McKee

1. WHEREAS, the ASUW Senate By-Laws, Article VI, Section 2, letter H
2. states, "I will not misuse my position as an elected representative or the
3. resources of ASUW for personal gain,"; and
4. WHEREAS, not having the ASUW Senate vote for UW Gold nominations
5. is in direct violation of the Code of Ethics; and
6. WHEREAS, each year money from the executive budget is set aside for
7. UW Gold nominees; and
8. WHEREAS, a limit of \$60 from the executive budget is a sufficient
9. amount for UW Gold nominees.
10. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated
11. Students of the University of Wyoming that the ASUW Vice President
12. be required to find out when the applications for UW Gold will be
13. available and when those applications are due; and
14. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the Student Senate of the
15. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that the ASUW Senate
16. will nominate no less than two members to be sponsored by ASUW for UW
17. Gold.
