1. WHEREAS, Senators of the Associated Students of the University of

2. Wyoming are directly elected by the students within their colleges and

3. should be held accountable to them; and

4. WHEREAS, students are often uninformed about the happenings in their

5. colleges and on campus and have little opportunity to provide input to the

6. powers that be; and

7. WHEREAS, students should have more opportunities to interact with the

8. administration, faculty, staff, and ASUW representatives of their colleges; and

9. WHEREAS, the 2003 Town Hall meetings received positive feedback from

10. administration, faculty and students, with requests for continuation.

11. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students

12. of the University of Wyoming that each college, in conjunction with ASUW,

13. will host a Town Hall meeting every spring and fall semester at a time

14. determined by the college contact of each college in place of a regularly

15. scheduled senate meeting; and

16. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that every elected or appointed member

17. of ASUW be required to attend their respective college town hall meetings as

18. per standard ASUW attendance guidelines; and

- 19. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the meetings should follow the
- 20. attached agenda (See Addendum A); and
- 21. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the meetings will be coordinated
- 22. by the Public Relations executive assistant and the Student Relations
- 23. Committee (this includes choosing the date and assembling appropriate
- 24. sample questions); and
- 25. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the responsibility for further
- 26. planning and implementation of each college's Town Hall meeting will be
- 27. that of the respective college contacts and senators.

- Questions will be taken from audience by moderator (prearranged questions will also be prepared by ASUW senators within college and by the Public Relations executive assistant and the Student Relations committee)
- Concluding statements by panelists
