- 1. WHEREAS, the current parking program has turned out to be a successful
- 2. alternative at the University of Wyoming; and
- 3. WHEREAS, there are still some problems that must be addressed to
- 4. maximize the use of the parking facilities at the University of Wyoming; and
- 5. WHEREAS, parking permits are only sold on an annual basis; and
- 6. WHEREAS, many students graduate in the fall and/or enter the University of
- 7. Wyoming at the start of the spring semester; and
- 8. WHEREAS, it is unfair to charge students for an annual permit that they
- 9. would only be valid for one semester (example: A student entering in the
- 10. spring would have to buy an annual permit that would expire in the summer.
- 11. Hence a permit only valid for one semester.).
- 12. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
- 13. Students of the University of Wyoming that all campus parking permits be
- 14. sold on an annual as well as a per-semester basis; and
- 15. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the permits sold on a per-semester
- 16. basis be sold at half the price of the annual permit.
