1. WHEREAS, the Stop Violence Program (SVP) provides an invaluable service

- 2. to the University of Wyoming; and
- 3. WHEREAS, Senate Bill #2099 allocated \$10,000 to the SVP for the purposes
- 4. of continuation of that program; and
- 5. WHEREAS, this monetary commitment from the Associated Students of the
- 6. University of Wyoming showed that this program was important to the
- 7. student body; and
- 8. WHEREAS, Senate Bill #2099 only allocated funds through October, 2005;
- 9. and
- 10. WHEREAS, the SVP acquired additional funding from other sources, due in
- 11. part to the support of the ASUW; and
- 12. WHEREAS, these additional sources of funding negated the need for the
- 13. ASUW funds to be used for its intended purpose.
- 14. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students
- 15. of the University of Wyoming that \$6,500 of the initially allocated \$10,000
- 16. be reallocated to the SVP for the purpose of self defense training for women;
- 17. and

- 18. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the remaining funds totaling \$3,500
- 19. be returned to the ASUW reserve; and
- 20. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that if funds have not been obligated by
- 21. June 1, 2006, the allocated \$6,500 be returned to the ASUW Reserve.
