1. WHEREAS, the state executive branch proposes that University of Wyoming

- 2. salary funding be increased by 3.5 percent each year of the biennium; and
- 3. WHEREAS, the executive branch proposal further includes a
- 4. recommendation to sustain the 85 percent employer contribution for employee
- 5. health insurance in light of anticipated increases; and
- 6. WHEREAS, the salary increases will help the institution recruit and retain the
- 7. very best faculty and staff, especially at a time when other state universities
- 8. are unable to significantly raise salaries; and
- 9. WHEREAS, the College of Arts and Sciences provides affordable and
- 10. quality programming to all University of Wyoming students through music,
- 11. theatre, and cultural experiences; and
- 12. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming is expected to be a cultural leader
- 13. within the state; and
- 14. WHEREAS, the cost of health insurance has increased 20 percent for Fiscal
- 15. Year 2007 (FY'07); and
- 16. WHEREAS, it is important that Student Health Services update their current
- 17. system to computer medical records; and
- 18. WHEREAS, a computer support specialist is needed to facilitate the

- 19. aforementioned technological change; and
- 20. WHEREAS, the Campus Activities Center is striving to enhance leadership
- 21. on campus through outreach to Recognized Student Organizations.
- 22. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University
- 23. of Wyoming that we support the proposed fee increases for FY '07 in
- 24. accordance with the stipulations contained in Addendum A.
