- WHEREAS, over 100 Conservation Corps in 36 states have been created 1.
- 2. since 1985 to provide community development and personal growth
- opportunities for young adults; and 3.
- WHEREAS, Wyoming is not currently among these 36 states; and 4.
- 5. WHEREAS, Wyoming's diverse environmental landscapes create an ideal
- 6. setting for the creation of a Wyoming Conservation Corps; and
- 7. WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
- recognize the need for student leadership and civic engagement opportunities; 8.

- WHEREAS, the WCC program would provide additional assistance to the 10.
- state for the improvement of the state's natural resources and open spaces; and 11.
- 12. WHEREAS, the Wyoming Conservation Corps will facilitate positive
- relationships between the University of Wyoming and conservation 13.
- 14. organizations across the State of Wyoming; and
- 15. WHEREAS, the WCC program would attract students to the University of
- 16. Wyoming to participate in the program; and
- WHEREAS, existing efforts to create a WCC have proven successful with 17.
- 18. state agencies, federal agencies, civic organizations and the University of

- 20. WHEREAS, the WCC has been approved to be housed in the Haub School
- 21. of Environment and Natural Resources; and
- 22. WHEREAS, the proposal to create a WCC is a student-led initiative; and
- 23. WHEREAS, the ASUW has the responsibility to respond to such initiatives.
- 24. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
- 25. Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW) that ASUW supports efforts
- 26. by the Wyoming State Legislature to create a state match to facilitate
- 27. operational costs for the Wyoming Conservation Corps; and
- 28. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the ASUW Director of Legislative
- 29. Affairs, in coordination with the proper ASUW officials, be responsible for
- 30. representing the interests of the students of the University of Wyoming to the
- 31. Wyoming State Legislature; and
- 32. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that this resolution be provided to the
- 33. President of the University of Wyoming, the University of Wyoming Vice
- -34. President for Academic Affairs, the Governor of Wyoming, interested
- 35. members of the Wyoming State Legislature, and members of the University
- 36. Board of Trustees.
