- 2. of Wyoming salary funding be increased by 3.5 % each year of the biennium
- 3. for merit salary increases; and

- 6. health insurance in light of anticipated increases; and
- 7. WHEREAS, the salary increases will help the institution recruit and retain the

- 9. unable to significantly raise salaries; and
- 10. WHEREAS, the cost of health insurance is anticipated to increase 20% for
- 11. Fiscal Year 2008 (FY 08); and
- 12. WHEREAS, the College of Arts and Sciences provides affordable and quality
- 13. programming to all University of Wyoming students through music, theatre,
- 14. and cultural experiences; and
- 15. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming is expected to be a cultural leader\
- 16. within the state; and
- 17. WHEREAS, Campus Recreation is a visible and highly used student service
- 18. that is in need of additional weekend staff; and

19.	WHEREAS, the Club Sports Program and Outdoor Adventure Program are			
20.	programs that enhance the total student experience at the University of			
21.	Wyoming; and			
22.	WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Recycling Program needs funds to			
23.	meet current program demands; and			
24.	WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Physical Plant Recycling Program			
25.	needs additional funding to sustain its current services; and			
26.	WHEREAS, student wellness is a primary concern for the University of			
27.	Wyoming; and			
28.	WHEREAS, the AWARE Program strives to promote student wellness

30.	WHEREAS, an additional graduate assistant is needed in the AWARE
