1. WHEREAS, the state of Wyoming executive branch, in conjunction with the office of the

2. President of the University of Wyoming mandates that University of Wyoming staff

3. salary funding be increased by an average of 4.5% for fiscal year 2009 in order to bring

4. the salaries equal to that of market value; and

5. WHEREAS, the executive branch proposal further includes a recommendation to sustain

6. the 85% employer contribution for employee health insurance in light of anticipated

7. increases; and

8. WHEREAS, the salary increases will help the institution recruit and retain the most

9. highly qualified staff available, especially at a time when other state universities are

10. unable to significantly raise salaries; and

11. WHEREAS, the Athletics Department provides thousands of seats at athletic venues

12. solely for student use without requiring the purchase of a ticket; and

13. WHEREAS the Athletics Department pledges to return at least \$25,000 in giveaways and

14. promotional items to University of Wyoming students; and

15. WHEREAS, Campus Recreation is a visible and highly used student service; and

16. WHEREAS, the Club Sports Program and Outdoor Adventure Program are programs that

17. enhance the student experience at the University of Wyoming and are in need of

18. additional staff; and

- WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Recycling Program needs funding to meet 19.
- 20. current program demands; and
- 21. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Physical Plant Recycling Program needs
- 22. additional funding to expand its current services; and
- 23. WHEREAS, the Wellness Center is in need of a full time athletic trainer; and
- 24. WHEREAS, Student Health provides an essential service available to all students; and
- 25. WHEREAS, the Wyoming Union is a facility integral to the student experience at the
- 26. University of Wyoming; and
- 27. WHEREAS, the Center for Volunteer Service has seen extensive personnel and
- 28. programmatic growth over the last three years and requires additional personnel; and
- 29. WHEREAS, the ASUW Mandatory Student Fee Committee recognizes the responsibility
- to recommend student fees that benefit a large population of students as well as fee units 30.
- that otherwise have no other option to financially sustain their demonstrated service to 31.
- 32. students; and
- WHEREAS, the ASUW recognizes the value in student leadership and Civic 33.
- 34. Engagement.
