

- 1. WHEREAS, the student senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) in fiscal year (FY) '09 allocated \$35,000 for the Special Projects Fund to be
- 3. expended in FY '10; and
- 4. WHEREAS, the ASUW Finance Policy states, "the ASUW Endowment may be used for
- 5. one-time projects that will benefit a large population for several years"; and
- 6. WHEREAS, the ASUW Budget and Planning Committee has reviewed applications,
- 7. researched proposals, and determined which projects best meet the specified guidelines.
- 8. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the student senate of the Associated Students of the
- 9. University of Wyoming that \$34,804.10 be allocated from the Special Projects Fund to the
- 10. request outlined in Addendum A.
