- 1. WHEREAS, the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW) recognizes
- 2. bicycle use is a valuable alternative means of transportation for international, undergraduate
- 3. and graduate students alike; and
- 4. WHEREAS, recently, the need for bicycle transportation has significantly increased as on
- 5. and off campus parking has drastically decreased; and
- 6. WHEREAS, environmental awareness efforts at the University of Wyoming have increased
- 7. in recent years; and
- 8. WHEREAS, bicycle traffic has increased on the University of Wyoming campus due to
- 9. decreased parking availability; and
- 10. WHEREAS, lack of the appropriate number of bicycle racks has led to improperly stored
- 11. bicycles on non-bicycle designated structures across campus; and
- 12. WHEREAS, bicycles provide a "sustainable, healthy, and environmentally friendly option
- 13. for transportation," (Senate Bill #2115); and
- 14. WHEREAS, in the last decade previous ASUW Senates have invested a total of \$28,100 in
- 15. sustainable, environmentally favorable, bicycle-friendly enhancements across the University
- 16. of Wyoming campus; and
- 17. WHEREAS, ASUW should continue its dedication to providing a bicycle-friendly campus
- 18. for all students;



- 19. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Police Department has agreed to pledge \$6,000.00
- 20. towards the purchase of bicycle racks upon the passage of this bill;
- 21. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 22. (ASUW) earmark \$6,000.00 from the Facilities Endowment to purchase additional bicycle
- 23. racks to increase the number of vacant bicycle spaces on the University of Wyoming campus;
- 24. and
- 25. THEREFORE, be it further enacted by the ASUW that the earmarked amount of \$6,000.00
- 26. be allocated no later than the end of fiscal year 2011, (FY11).
