- 1. WHEREAS, the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act (H.R. 1547/S. 781) eliminates a
- 2. distinction in existing tax law that would result in allowing tax-exempt charitable and
- 3. educational organizations to make grants to non-University owned not-for-profit student
- 4. housing entities that provide collegiate student housing; and
- 5. WHEREAS, the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act would make college more
- 6. affordable at no cost to taxpayers by offering a housing alternative less expensive than
- 7. University housing; and
- 8. WHEREAS, the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act results in safer student housing
- 9. by encouraging charitable contributions to collegiate housing for installation of life saving
- 10. equipment such as fire sprinklers, smoke detectors, and alarm systems; and
- 11. WHEREAS, approximately three percent of students the University of Wyoming live in non
- 12. University-owned not-for-profit housing during their collegiate years.
- 13. THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Associated Students at the University of Wyoming
- 14. supports Congressional passage of the Collegiate Housing and Infrastructure Act; and
- 15. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Associated Students at the University of
- 16. Wyoming asks the Wyoming Congressional Delegation to co-sponsor the Collegiate Housing
- 17. and Infrastructure Act.
