- WHEREAS, the Student Government of the Associated Students of the University of
- Wyoming (ASUW) is dedicated to providing support to its programs and services; and,
- WHEREAS, the Associated Students Technical Services (ASTEC) is an ASUW program
- dedicated to providing electronic, technical, audio, and visual assistance to student
- programming across campus; and,
- WHEREAS, the ASTEC Technical Services Coordinator currently uses a majority of
- specified work time working at events and venues providing integral assistance to student
- and university employees to deliver the best aforementioned programming; and,
- WHEREAS, having an individual working solely in the ASTEC Office to help with daily
- 10. office tasks including answering phones, answering e-mails, fielding questions from visitors,
- 11. corresponding with ASUW Office Staff, etc. would fulfill responsibilities the ASTEC
- 12. Technical Services Coordinator is unable to fulfill because of the extremely busy work
- 13, schedule; and,
- 14. WHEREAS, the ASUW Reserve Fund "shall be maintained for the purposes of securing
- 15. the ongoing development of the activities, programs, and advancement of the ideals of the
- 16. Associated Students of the University of Wyoming."
- 17. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
- 18. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that three thousand forty dollars (\$3,040) be allocated from
