- 1. WHEREAS, the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) have voted in support for the Transition of ASUW SafeRide to Transit & Parking
- 3. Services; and
- WHEREAS. The ASUW has voted to not fund program such as ASUW Student Radio
- 5. Station (also known as UW Radio Station); and
- WHEREAS, The current list of ASUW Programs does not reflect these changes and requires
- revision.
- 8. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of
- 9. Wyoming (ASUW) that the ASUW By-Laws Article II, Section 10, Subsection A, Clause viii,
- 10. Subclause c be amended to reflect the changes contained in Addendum A; and
- 11. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the ASUW By-Laws Article VIII, Section 1, Subsection
- 12. C, Clause i be amended to reflect the changes contained in Addendum B; and,
- 13. THEREFORE, be it resolved that the ASUW Budget and Planning Committee include the
- 14. aforementioned language changes when preparing the ASUW Budget for Fiscal Year 2013
- 15. (FY13).
- 16. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that this legislation shall take effect on July 1, 2012.

Addendum A

THE BY-LAW ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING

ARTICLE II

Legislative Branch

Section 10. Senate Committees:

- A. In order to provide continuity in ASUW activities and business along with providing a mechanism for timely participation by the ASUW in University processes, the following permanent ASUW Senate committees are established:
- viii. The ASUW Students' Program Advisory Committee:
 - c. <u>Composition</u>. The Committee shall consist of a minimum of five (5) Senators of the ASUW, one (1) of whom shall serve as chairperson, three (3) ASUW Students-at-Large, one (1) being a Freshman Senator, and a unique student representative of each ASUW program or service shall have the opportunity to serve as a voting member.
 - a. These program and service representatives may be from, but not limited to:
 - i. Associated Students Technical Services (ASTEC)
 - ii. United Multicultural Council
 - iii. ASUW Student Radio Station
 - iviii. A.L. Lupton Financial Literacy Program
 - *-iv. Freshman Senate
 - vi.v. Students' Attorney Program
 - wii-vi. Non-Traditional Student Council
 - viii. Panhellenic Council
 - interfraternity Council
 - xix. SafeRide

b. All these program and service representatives are subject to the final approval of the ASUW Vice President. All program and service representatives will have the right to vote in this Committee. The ASUW Vice President shall appoint one (1) Executive Assistant to serve as an ex-officio on the committee.

THE BY-LAW ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING

Article VIII

Services and Programs

Section 1. All services and programs funded by the ASUW shall be placed in one (1), and only one (1), of the following categories:
