- 1. WHEREAS, the Student Government of the Associated Students of the University of
- 2. Wyoming (ASUW) should practice the most sustainable and efficient processes in its
- 3. operations; and,
- 4. WHEREAS, neither the ASUW By-Laws nor Rules and Procedures address the use of
- 5. electronics at weekly ASUW meetings (i.e. Senate, Committee); and,
- 6. WHEREAS, the use of laptops, netbooks and tablets would dramatically decrease the amount
- 7. of paper used by the ASUW Senate; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, the use of these electronics will make the ASUW Senate more efficient; and,
- 9. WHEREAS, the use of previously mentioned electronics should only be used for business
- 10. purposes that are directly related to ASUW functions.
- 11. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
- 12. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that Article VI of the ASUW Rules and Procedures be
- 13. amended to reflect the addition of Section 4 contained in Addendum A.

## RULES AND PROCEDURES ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING

## ARTICLE VI

Legislative Action

Section 4. Use-of-Electronics Protocol

- A. Mobile electronics, not limited to laptops, netbooks, and tabletsexceeding a maximum 12" diagonal screen dimension may be used during ASUW functions for ASUW business purposes only.
  - i. Abuse of this protocol will be addressed by the ASUW Steering Committee and may be subject to disciplinary action pursuant with the Committee's usual discipline.
