

- UW assured admission standards proposal #2
 - o Considered UW admission standards that include requirements of:
 - High School GPA of 3.0
- UW assured admission standards proposal #3
 - o Considered UW admission standards that require:
 - ACT score of 21 or higher (or SAT \geq 990)
- UW assured admission standards proposal #4
 - Consider UW admission standards that include:
 - Conditional admission for students not meeting assured admission standards
 - Offer participated in Synergy program or other support programs, such as an academic transition course
 - Give priority to Wyoming students for the Synergy program
- UW assured admission standards proposal #5
 - Consider UW admissions standards that include:
 - No change to UW's admission requirements for transfer students; encourage students to complete an associate's degree or ~60 credits prior to transferring to UW
 - Transfer students with a > 30 college credits are admitted if they have a college GPA of > of 2.0.
 - Transfer students with < 30 college credits and a high school diploma are admitted if they also meet the requirements for 1st year, first-time student applicants.
