**TITLE: Sale of Malt Beverages at Athletic Events**

1. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Student Government of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming (ASUW) to act on behalf of the student interest by providing varied
3. services; and
4. WHEREAS, student opinion shows a strong support of the sale of malt beverages at sporting
5. events; and
6. WHEREAS, such sale could generate a substantial amount of revenue for both the Athletic
7. Department and the University as a whole; and
8. WHEREAS, said sale is not construed as an endorsement of the use of alcohol by
9. intercollegiate athletics or the University; and
10. WHEREAS, the purchase by spectators of malt beverages is a personal choice that shall not
11. be regulated by the University; and
12. WHEREAS, said sale could actually lead to increased safety and control of both students and
13. non-student spectators when accompanied by an effective gate policy; and
14. WHEREAS, Senate Resolution #1688 was passed in the ASUW Senate, that detailed the
15. student support for the sale of malt beverages at athletic events at the UW; and
16. WHEREAS, University of Wyoming department of athletics already has an existing policy
17. with regards to the consumption and sale of malt beverages and spirits in the Wildcatter

18. Stadium Boxes and Suites.

19. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Government of the Associated Students of the

20. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that we encourage the sale of malt beverages at all home
