# RULES AND PROCEDURES ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WYOMING

## **Article VI**Legislative Action

#### Section 1. Legislative Process

K. In the case of an emergency, a bill or resolution may be voted on in the meeting of its introduction if the Senate, by a four-fifths (4/5) vote of its members present, shall vote to suspend the rules. (Suspends Article \(\frac{\frac{1}}{2}\), Paragraphs B and C) After such action, the proper committee shall be asked for its recommendation. This

# Article X Suspension

These rules, or any portion thereof, may be temporarily suspended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the ASUW Senate with the exceptions of Article VI, Section 1, Paragraphs B and C, which require a four-fifths (4/5) vote.
