

- 2. Wyoming (ASUW) is dedicated to encouraging and promoting cultural diversity and
- 3. understanding on the University of Wyoming campus and in the lives of UW
- 4. students; and,
- 5. WHEREAS, the 2014 ASUW Shanghai Leadership Exchange is a cooperative effort between
- 6. the University of Wyoming, Shanghai University and Shanghai Normal University to
- 7. encourage interaction and learning between student leaders during the 2013-2014 academic
- 8. year; and,
- 9. WHEREAS, the Vice President of Student Affairs is partnering with the ASUW Student
- 10. Government to organize and finance the Exchange; and,
- 11. WHEREAS, the Exchange would serve as an invaluable educational opportunity for the
- 12. entire student body to interact and share with the partner institutions' delegation through
- 13. the Exchange activities; and,
- 14. WHEREAS, programs organized by the UW delegation upon its return will enrich UW
- 15. students and encourage future international cooperation; and,
- 16. WHEREAS, the legislative and financial support of the ASUW Student Government is
- 17. essential to the success of the Exchange; and,
- 18. WHEREAS, \$8000 was allocated through End-of-Year spending in Fiscal Year '11 for a



- 19. similar exchange; and,
- 20. WHEREAS, \$4,346.02 was left after the previous Exchange, and transferred back to the
- 21. ASUW Reserve in 2013.
- 22. THEREFORE, be it enacted that the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
- 23. University of Wyoming allocate \$4,346.02 from the Reserve to partially fund UW students
- 24. who have been selected to participate in the Shanghai Leadership Exchange.
