TITLE: Special Projects Spending Act for Fiscal Year 2015

DATE: November 13, 2014

1. WHEREAS, the annually accrued interest generated by the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming (ASUW) Endowment (Special Projects Endowment) is used, as
3. stated in the ASUW Finance Policy, to fund one-time projects which benefit a large segment
4. of students; and,
5. WHEREAS, the Budget & Planning Committee reviewed applications, investigated projects,
6. and determined which projects best fulfill the stated purpose of the Special Projects
7. Endowment; and,
8. WHEREAS, there is a total of \$40,000.00 in expendable funds from the Special Projects
9. Endowment available for Fiscal Year 2015.
10. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
11. University of Wyoming that \$37,781.70 be allocated from the Special Projects
12. Endowment to fund the project requests as outlined in Addendum A.
