1. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming (ASUW) to reach out to as many students as possible; and,
3. WHEREAS, a record number of students voted in the 2014 ASUW General Elections; and,
4. WHEREAS, the ASUW Elections Committee continues to break this record each year; and,
5. WHEREAS, the ASUW General Elections reach students in every college of the University of
6. Wyoming; and,
7. WHEREAS, surveys conducted on campus this academic school year have only reached up to two
8. hundred students; and,
9. WHEREAS, the ASUW Student Outreach and Policy (SOP) Committee has done extensive
10. research and development on the potential construction of a parking garage by working with the
11. Dean of Students office, Residence Life and Dining Services, Physical Plant, Auxiliary Services,
12. and Parking and Transit; and,
13. WHEREAS, information about permit cost amounts and optimal parking garage locations is
14. needed to continue advocacy for building a parking garage based on student opinion; and,
15. WHEREAS, the Student Outreach and Policy (SOP) Committee has developed a three question
16. survey to gather this information.
