Addendum A

ARTICLE V

Legislative System

The privilege of holding an elected or appointed position as an ASUW representative shall be in accordance with the following provisions.

Section 1. Mechanics – All major actions shall be submitted in bill form.

E. In the case of a bill, the proposal <u>first therefore clause</u> shall begin by stating, "Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that..." "Be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW) Student Government..."
