- 1. WHEREAS, it is the mission of the Associated Students of the University of
- 2. Wyoming (ASUW) Student Government to provide responsible, effective leadership,
- 3. which predicates productive and decisive action by the ASUW Student Government when
- 4. difficult decisions face our university; and,
- 5. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming's (UW) mission statement (March 2009) states
- 6. that the university serves as a statewide resource for accessible and affordable higher
- 7. education of the highest quality; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, given the stretched resources of both the State of Wyoming, and the
- 9. university, prioritization of interests must be made for strategic budget planning; and,
- 10. WHEREAS, the university's funding from the State of Wyoming, being a block grant,
- 11. creates a conflict between three major interests, those being accessibility, affordability, and a
- 12. high quality educational experience; and,
- 13. WHEREAS, limiting accessibility to higher education, and lowering the number of students
- 14. admitted to UW may both prevent a diverse group of students from attending our university
- 15. and result in fewer students receiving the important socioeconomic benefits provided by
- 16. higher education; and,
- 17. WHEREAS, the quality of the educational experience provided at UW is vital to the current
- 18. and future success of the students, our constituents; and,
- 19. WHEREAS, a failure to provide increased funding will have a significant and detrimental

- 20. effect on the quality of the education experience at UW; and,
- 21. WHEREAS, the effects of the proposed 4% increase in tuition outlined in Addendum A
- 22. although seemingly undesirable if taken at face value in their own right may be necessary to
- 23. prevent worse outcomes for students at the university.
- 24. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the
- 25. University of Wyoming (ASUW) Student Government that barring significant positive
- 26. changes in the State of Wyoming's capacity to raise revenue in the biennium of Fiscal Year
- 27. 2017-2018, the ASUW Student Government finds a 4% tuition increase as proposed by the
- 28. University of Wyoming Board of Trustees acceptable on a one time basis given the lack of
- 29. other more desirable options; and,
- 30. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the ASUW does not support an increase in tuition if
- 31. the funds raised are not used specifically to ensure that the quality of educational experiences
- 32. provided to students is increased, or kept consistent; and,
- 33. THEREFORE, be it further resolved by the ASUW that the ASUW seek out and also
- 34. encourage appropriate UW entities to advertise tuition increase info and reasoning to UW
- 35. student and continue to seek student input
