Addendum A

ARTICLE IV

Appointed or Elected Officers

The privilege of holding an elected or appointed position as an ASUW representative shall be in accordance with the following provisions.

A member of the ASUW may be removed from office in the ASUW Executive, Legislative, or Judicial branches if he/she hasthey have been found to be on conduct probation as assigned by a Student Judicial Affairs Officer in the Dean of Students Office, or if he has been found guilty of other acts which compromise his/hertheir integrity as a student leader and representative of the ASUW. This standard must be maintained throughout the term of office.
