TITLE: ASUW Support for WyASC Summer Leadership Conference

DATE INTRODUCED: April 4, 2017

1. WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW)
2. Student Government to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible; and,
3. WHEREAS, the ASUW Student Government has fostered a strong connection with the
4. Wyoming Association of Student Councils (WyASC) for many years, for the growth of
5. leaders in Wyoming; and,
6. WHEREAS, the ASUW Student Government currently travels to the annual WyASC
7. Convention to host workshops, network, and promote the University of Wyoming (UW);
8. and,
9. WHEREAS, WyASC is moving their annual Summer Leadership Conference (SLC) to the
10. UW campus for the first time in the summer of 2018; and,
11. WHEREAS, this offers a unique opportunity for ASUW Student Government leaders to
12. interact with the student delegates attending the conference to promote leadership, service,
13. and UW; and,
14. WHEREAS, UW has a strong focus on recruitment and retention of incoming students; and,
15. WHEREAS, when students attending SLC on the UW campus will be exposed to state-of-the-
16. art facilities, dynamic educational opportunities, and feel more welcome on our campus; and,
17. WHEREAS, many student leaders, in all clubs and organizations at UW, participated in
18. WyASC during high school and developed leadership, civic engagement, and commitment to
19. service.

20. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
21. (ASUW) that \$700 be allocated from the ASUW Reserve to the Wyoming Association of
22. Student Councils (WyASC) for their Summer Leadership Conference to be hosted on the
23. University of Wyoming campus; and,
24. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the members of the Intersession Oversight
25. Committee ensure that the funding goes to returning attendees of SLC as a scholarship
26. for cost of attendance and as prospective University of Wyoming Students; and,
27. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that members of the Intersession Oversight Committee
28. coordinate with WyASC program directors included in the conference to
29. draft a report on the shared experience of WyASC and the ASUW Student Government.
