- 1. WHEREAS, it is the Mission of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) Student Government "to serve our students in the best manner possible through
- 3. accurate representation, professional interaction with campus programs and organizations,

- 5. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming's mission is to prepare students to be successful
- 6. after graduation; and,
- 7. WHEREAS, the national average student debt is \$30,000; and,
- 8. WHEREAS, many students live paycheck to paycheck, and many students are not taught
- 9. the basics of financial literacy; and,
- 10. WHEREAS, many students spend money on frivolous items without the proper means, due
- 11. to their lack of knowledge of financial literacy basics; and,
- 12. WHEREAS, members of Faculty Senate have stated their support for financial literacy;

- 14. WHEREAS, certain First-Year Seminar courses already use financial literacy as part of
