TITLE: ASUW Support for Regularly Reviewing and Updating Sexua

Misconduct Policies and Procedures

1. WHEREAS, it is the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming

2. (ASUW) Student Government to represent our fellow students through responsible, effective

3. leadership; and,

4. WHEREAS, per a 2007 National Institute of Justice report, "About one in five women and

5. six percent of men are victims of a completed or attempted sexual assault while in college";

6. and,

7. WHEREAS, the prevalence of sexual assault and other forms of sexual misconduct is a

8. nationally recognized epidemic on college campuses; and,

9. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming (UW) is dedicated to providing its students.

10. faculty, staff, and visitors a living and learning environment that is safe and secure; and,

11. WHEREAS, UW has many prevention and response services in place to help provide the

12. highest levels of campus safety; and,

13. WHEREAS, despite all of this, UW is not immune to the epidemic of sexual misconduct on

14. college campuses; and,

15. WHEREAS, there has been growing concern among UW students, faculty, and staff with the

16. number of sexual assault reports on campus during the 2016-2017 academic year; and,

17. WHEREAS, President Laurie Nichols charged Associate Vice President and Dean of

18. Students Sean Blackburn and Interim Title IX Coordinator Jim Osborn to form a team

- 19. comprised of UW Police Department, ASUW, Safe Project, and Stop Violence to expand
- 20. sexual misconduct prevention and response efforts; and,
- 21. WHEREAS, this team has already implemented several efforts to improve prevention and
- 22. response efforts, such as a new REPORT IT website, increased mandatory student and
- 23. employee education, and the campus wide adoption of the NO MORE campaign; and,
- 24. WHEREAS, the UW Sexual Misconduct Policies and Procedures, as outlined by Appendix A
- 25. of UW Regulation 1-256, has not been updated since 2014; and,
- 26. WHEREAS, while the policy and the definitions contained within are still accurate, a
- 27. process should exist through which UW's definition of sexual misconduct and related
- 28. policies may be reviewed and updated regularly, considering national trends and
- 29. circumstances.
- 30. THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 31. (ASUW) Student Government supports the creation of a process through which the
- 32. University of Wyoming (UW) Sexual Misconduct Policies and Procedures, as outlined in
- 33. Appendix A to UW Regulation 1-256, may be reviewed and updated regularly with student
- 34. input; and,
- 35. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that ASUW members, Voices of Courage members, and
- 36. any other students or groups of interest be involved in the review process; and,
- 37. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the ASUW Student Government recommends that
- 38. UW take all necessary measures to further educate and disseminate the UW Sexual
- 39. Misconduct Policies and Procedures as they exist in current and future updated forms among
- 40. students.
