

1. WHEREAS, it is the intention of the ASUW Budget and Planning Committee to
2. fully allocate the Special Projects Fund; and
3. WHEREAS, there has consistently been residual monies from the Special Projects
4. Fund; and
5. WHEREAS, the Finance Policy states that these residual monies be returned to
6. the ASUW Endowment; and
7. WHEREAS, this money could be effectively allocated without returning it to the
8. ASUW Endowment to further benefit the students of the University of Wyoming.
9. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of
10. the University of Wyoming that clause E be added to Section VI of the ASUW
11. Finance Policy as follows (see addendum).


