Title: Proposed Student Fee from Union Board

1. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Union Board has proposed a \$1
2. operational and a \$1 programming fee increase, for a set total of a \$2 student
3. fee increase per semester effective Fall 2000; and
4. WHEREAS, the University of Wyoming Student Union will be under
5. construction for at least the next 2 years; and
6. WHEREAS, this construction will reduce possible programming events held
7. in the Student Union; and
8. WHEREAS, students will incur a \$22/semeseter Union Renovation fee in
9. Fall 2002; and
10. WHEREAS, Union Programming budgets were not fully utilized during the
11. Fiscal Year 1999.
12. THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Associated Students of the University of
13. Wyoming Senate does not support a \$1 programming fee increase per semester as
14. proposed by the University of Wyoming Union Board; and
15. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that the Associated Students of the
16. University of Wyoming Senate approves of a set \$1 operational fee increase per
17. semester as proposed by the University of Wyoming Union Board.


