### SENATE BILL #2708

**TITLE:** Finance Policy Edits – Article 3, Sections 3.01 and 3.03

**SPONSORS:** Student Organization Funding Board

- 1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 2. (ASUW) Student Government is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible;
- 3. and,
- 4. WHEREAS, the Finance Policy of the ASUW can be convoluted and confusing to
- 5. students both outside and within the organization; and,
- 6. WHEREAS, the term of Recognized Student Organization (RSO) was changed recently
- 7. to only be Student Organization (SO); and,
- 8. WHEREAS, the Student Organization Funding Board (SOFB) is not expecting to hear a
- 9. lot of requests for event funding this semester due to the COVID-19 restrictions set in
- 10. place on campus; and,
- 11. WHEREAS, in an effort to promote transparency and accessibility for the ASUW, the
- 12. SOFB is working as a committee to balance marketing its services to student
- 13. organizations to be able to expend the funds allocated to them and updating its internal
- 14. documents to be more understandable for SOs; and,
- 15. WHEREAS, minor grammatical edits are necessary to make the working documents of
- 16. the ASUW professional and comprehensible; and,
- 17. WHEREAS, updates to policies are needed every so often to reflect the times.
- 18. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
- 19. (ASUW) Student Government that the Finance Policy be amended to reflect the changes
- 20. outlined in Addendum A; and,

### Addendum A

## Article 1. ASUW RSO FUNDING BOARD AUTHORITY AND GUIDELINES

### Section 1.01 RSO Funding Board Authority

- 1. ASUW Programs, Services, and Strategic Partners shall not receive any funding from the ASUW RSO Funding Board.
- 2. The ASUW Senate through the RSO Funding Board possesses sole authority to allocate ASUW funds directly to RSOs which are not Programs, Services, or Strategic Partners of the ASUW.
- 3. Only the ASUW RSO Funding Board shall have authority to allocate ASUW funds directly to an RSO.
  - A. If an ASUW Program, Service, or Strategic Partner wishes to forfeit a portion of its allocated budget to support RSO programming it may transfer those funds directly to the RSO Funding Board.
  - B. Funds transferred to the RSO Funding Board from any ASUW Program, Service, or Strategic Partner become part of the general fund of the RSO Funding Board.
  - C. The ASUW entity that forfeits funds shall have no influence as to the group or program to which the transferred funds are reallocated by the RSO Funding Board.
- 4. RSOs shall <u>notonly</u> receive funding from ASUW for normal operating expenses, membership fees, dues, or organizational publications <u>unless</u>if the RSO is deemed a Strategic Partner, as <u>outlined</u> in the <u>ASUW By-Laws</u>.
- 5. The RSO Funding Board shall have the authority to approve requests totaling less than \$3,500.00.
- 6. Any request of \$3,500.00 or more that is approved by the RSO Funding Board shall be subject to final approval by the ASUW Senate.
- 7. All votes concerning final funding allotments by the ASUW Senate shall be conducted via a standing vote.

# Section 1.03 <u>Funding Allocation Guidelines</u>

- 1. Each RSO may be awarded up to \$10,000.00 from the RSO Funding Board per fiscal year.
  - A. Each SO may be awarded up to \$3,500.00 of unmatched funds from the SO Funding Board per fiscal year.
  - B. If an RSO wishes to exceed \$3,500.00 of unmatched funds, the SO must provide documentation of non-ASUW matching funds of at least 10% for the amount exceeding \$3,500.00.

- 1. Exceptions to this rule shall be at the discretion of the RSO Funding Board, and the totality of event requests, including any exception to this rule, shall need approval of the ASUW Senate.
- 2. Exceptions to the outside funding requirement should be made on the basis of the effort by the RSO to secure outside funding, the availability of funds across campus, and the current fiscal environment of campus.
- C. The annual cap per RSO, and the percentage of outside funds RSOs need to provide for requests over the capped amount, will be reviewed and adjusted, if necessary, in the spring semester of every even-numbered yeartwo years by the RSO Funding Board.
