TITLE: Expenditures of the ASUW Student Services Endowment

DATE INTRODUCED: April 20, 2021

1. WHEREAS, the purpose of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
2. (ASUW) Student Government is to serve our fellow students in the best manner possible;
3. and,
4. WHEREAS, the ASUW Student Services Endowment (Facilities Endowment) was created
5. through Senate Bill #2042; and,
6. WHEREAS, the purpose of this endowment is to, “finance the enhancement of student
7. service buildings, venues, or other projects at the University of Wyoming as designated by
8. the ASUW Student Government”; and,
9. WHEREAS, as of December 31, 2021 there is \$566,236.18 available for appropriation from
10. the Facilities Endowment; and,
11. WHEREAS, the 108th administration has identified various areas on campus that could
12. benefit from these funds, including Special Projects requests that were not funded due to
13. lack of funds and projects that meet the goals and platforms of the 108th administration;
14. and,
15. WHEREAS, Addendum A outlines all proposed expenditures from the Facilities
16. Endowment.
17. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
18. (ASUW) Student Government that a total of \$270,500 be allocated from the Student

19. Services Endowment (Facilities Endowment) to fund areas and projects outlined in
20. Addendum A; and,
21. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that upon passage, the ASUW President shall work in
22. coordination with the ASUW Business Office to ensure these units receive their
23. appropriations before the end of the Fiscal Year 2021; and,
24. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that any unspent monies from this allocation be
25. returned back to the ASUW Facilities Endowment.

Addendum A

Unit or Area/Price	Description of Project
Disability Support Services/\$50,500	Previous SP Request; B&P allocated \$4,220 to supply them with 5 camera monitoring systems and the associated licenses. This would fund the rest of their request to renovate their space to create a testing center.
Student Organizations & Entertainment/\$50,000	Renovate the green rooms of the Arts & Sciences Auditorium including renovating the sinks and toilets, painting the 3 rooms and bathrooms, updating furniture, and install floor coverings and countertops.
Wyoming Union/\$75,000	Previous Facilities Endowment funds were allocated to the Union for the renovating toilets. These renovations were found not feasible due to Union piping. Worked with the Union to identify other needs. These monies will go towards LED lighting in the Union.
UW Facilities/\$10,000	Create more curb cuts in front of the College of Health Sciences. The Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion identified this need due to requests from students who have a disability.
UW Facilities/\$85,000	Renovate three bathrooms in buildings at UW to make them all-gender and single use. Extra monies will be used to help buy signage.
